

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION http://StPatricksBR.archtoronto.org/sacraments

Families with children *entering* Grade 2 (anticipating the celebration of First Communion) and students *entering* Grade 7 (anticipating the celebration of Confirmation), as well as older children for either Sacrament should begin to consider next year's preparation and celebration cycle.

Parents are asked to prepare a copy of the Baptism certificate of their child (available from the church where they were Baptized). This will be a requirement for the registration that will happen sometime in Fall 2024. *Those Baptized here at Saint Patrick's, Wildfield do not need a copy for registration.*

Families are also reminded that the Sacraments should be celebrated at the parish church that they regularly attend on Sundays, regardless of which parish their child's school is connected.
