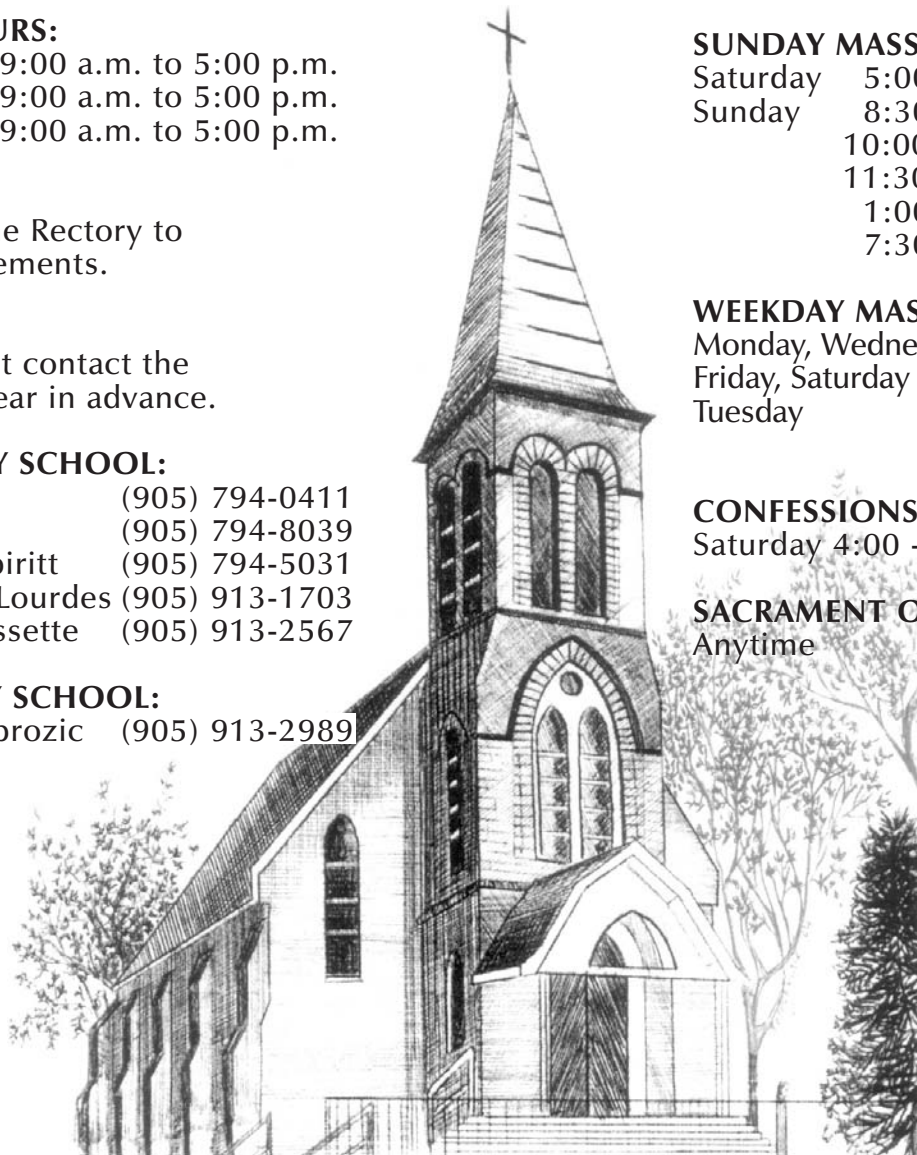

FROM THE DESK OF FR. VITO

Greetings & Blessings dear friends and parishioners of St. Patrick's Church



With the Feast of Christ the King, and the weekdays that follow, we conclude the Liturgical Year of the Church. Each ending makes way to a new beginning. As we bid "farewell" to the Year of St. Matthew, we welcome the Year of St. Luke with all the blessings that the Word of God and the Breaking of the Bread will bestow upon our Church and upon our World. We look forward to the many gifts that our celebrations, our learning, our outreach, the new groups emerging, all that has been part of our faith community in the past, and all that is now and will be in the future, will bring to us.

As we prepare to embark upon the New Year of the Church, beginning with the First Sunday of Advent next weekend, we look at the **BEGINNING WORK FOR OUR NEW CHURCH BUILDING**. Last Monday, November 20, our community was invited to meet with our Architect, Mr. Renzo Pillon, to view, comment and discuss the proposed drawings for the **NEW CHURCH BUILDING**. These preliminary drawings offered an opportunity for us to glance at the result of the past year's discussions, planning, vision, etc., making room for changes, additions, comments and dialogue.

I thank the parishioners who came to the meeting. I **MUST ADMIT, HOWEVER, THAT THE NUMBER IN ATTENDANCE WAS NOT WHAT I PERSONALLY EXPECTED**. 52 participants offered their comments and questions to the architect. I **THANK THEM SINCERELY**. I do realize that so many commitments get in the way, **BUT I CANNOT EMPHASIZE ENOUGH** how strategically important and essentials these meetings are. In order to go forward a much larger response is needed.

THEREFORE: A second meeting with the architect has been set up for Tuesday, DECEMBER 5, at 8 pm in the church. My vision is that at least ONE MEMBER from each family be present and through the presentation and discussion become a spokesperson to the family and others with regards to our plans.

The interviews held by the M and M International Consultants prove that 99.99% of all interviewed are in great favour and strongly support the building of our new church. **BUT NOW WE NEED TO GET GOING** and in order to do so, we need to present our views and add our suggestions, present our questions and offer our comments.

It is my hope, therefore, that many will make the SECOND GATHERING, on Tuesday, DECEMBER 5, AT 8:00 pm a successful moment and a great start to the process.
