SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION



Now that this years' celebrations have occurred, it is time to begin planning for next year. Year by year, we try to do our best to help families in their role of

preparing the children for the Sacraments. We know that each family has different needs and commitments which may limit their time or resources. Do trust the fact that we take into consideration everything, in order to make the experience of both preparation and celebration what will help the child and the family the most. With the beginning of September, we will have information meetings and registrations that will continue until the end of October. In the beginning of November, we begin the "final steps of the preparation." "Final" because the actual preparation began at your child's baptism.

What can we do during the Summer? Please prepare a copy of your child's baptismal certificate which will be needed at the time of registration. For those preparing for Confirmation, the Summer would be a good opportunity for them to focus on who the sponsor for Confirmation should be. Please remember that a sponsor must be at least 16 years old, male or female, baptized, confirmed and practising in the Catholic Church.

ALSO, IMPORTANT TO NOTE: According to Archdiocesan Law, the Sacraments MUST TAKE PLACE in the church where the family worships on Sunday. The Sacraments ARE NOT part of a school event. We are truly blessed with the gift of Catholic Schools, and all that our schools do to help us prepare the children. The celebration, however, belongs to the community in which the child and the child's family worship on a regular Sunday basis. Children who attend public schools will be invited to participate in Catechetical instructions provided by the parish. If you have any guestions on this information, please contact Fr. Vito.
