**PLEASE NOTE:** It is important for a family member to attend the information meetings. On that day, we will provide each person present with a registration form to be filled and prepared for registrations which will take place on assigned dates in the middle of the month of October. Upon registration all information and dates for meetings and celebration of the Sacraments will be handed out. Preparation begins in November. If a family member cannot attend the designated day for their school, please come to one of the other dates. If possible, parents only.

ALSO NOTE that all dates have been decided and are now available. You can pick the sheet of dates up from the church any Sunday after Mass. IN ORDER TO REGISTER FOR THE SACRAMENT, the family must have attended one of the information meetings. If you cannot attend the evening assigned to your school, you can attend any one of them. We ask you to be punctual for the meeting. They are only 40 minutes in duration, and there are many other meeting and events that take place every evening. A PUNCTUAL PRESENCE IS NECESSARY. Thank you.

ALSO, IMPORTANT TO NOTE: According to Archdiocesan Law, the Sacraments MUST TAKE PLACE in the church where the family worships on Sunday. The Sacraments ARE NOT part of a school event. We are truly blessed with the gift of Catholic Schools, and all that our schools do to help us prepare the children. The celebration, however, belongs to the community in which the child and the child's family worship on a regular Sunday basis. Children who attend public schools will be invited to participate in Catechetical instructions provided by the parish. If you have any questions on this information, please contact Fr. Vito.
