FROM THE DESK OF FR. VITO Greetings & Blessings dear friends and parishioners of St. Patrick's Church

St. Paul addresess the faithful to whom his letters are written as "Saints". ie: "To the Saints who are in the Church of Ephesus..." He did not mean the representations of saints in their places of worship, but the men, women and



children who gathered in those places of worship. Why keep this precious gift away from our religious and spiritual experience. Please remember that the parish (this and all others) offer many opportunities to celebrate this moment of grace. If you wish to have a longer time to perhaps express concerns or have a longer dialogue, please contact me and we will arrange a time. Let us take this month of November, and Advent to follow in December, to be reminded that we are "Saints", and to allow God's grace in the Sacrament to let our "halo" shine brightly at all times.
