Blessings of Peace upon all, as we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. We have begun a new year filled with Christmas blessings, and we now immerse ourselves in Ordinary Time. This "Ordinary Time", which will lead us to Lent, is by no means a time of "little interest". It is rather an opportunity

given to us to acknowledge that God is at work at all times; God's grace surrounds us, strengthens us, enlightens us in every moment. Our God is the God of the moment, each moment, at all times. God's love is not only to be seen and celebrated in special circumstances and events. The "Ordinary Time" of the liturgy is a true blessing, as it opens for us a number of opportunities to realize that we do not have to wait for special occasions to celebrate his love, but the "here and now"; every "here and now" is God's blessings at work.

Also, at the celebration of the Anointing of the Sick, we will bless the new Statue of Our Lady which, in the Spring, will be placed outside our church, at the spot where, a few months ago, the Statue of Our Lady which was venerated in that spot for a number of years was broken.

Let us rejoice and be glad in every occasion, every day, because indeed: "This is the Day the Lord has made. Let us rejoice and be glad."
