FASTING & ABSTINENCE

The rule concerning Fasting and Abstinence is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Abstinence is to be observed all Fridays throughout the year, however, Catholics may substitute this practice with special acts of charity and piety on the other Fridays. It remains to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Abstinence refrains from consumption of meat and it pertains to everyone over fourteen years of age. Fasting prescribes that only one meal be taken in the day, but it does not forbid taking more nourishment as the person's health and activities of the day may require. Fasting binds those between eighteen and sixty years of age. Individual cases, for just reason (i.e. the sick), receive dispensation from these obligations. Let us remember the words of Jesus: "One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God." Mt. 4:4



STATIONS OF THE CROSS DURING LENT

As a parish community, we gather to pray the Stations of the Cross communally on

Wednesday evenings during Lent at 7:30 pm (in Italian) and on Friday mornings, during Lent, at 9 am, following the 8:30 am Mass in English. We encourage individuals and families to come during the day when time allows, and pray the stations. Copies of prayers may be found at the doors of the church for anyone to use.
