#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. VITO Greetings parishioners and dear friends of St. Patrick's Church





On this Shepherds Trust Sunday, as we are called to offer our prayers and support to retired priests in the Archdiocese, I wish to express my love and gratitude to the many priests in my life who have helped me

understand and shape my vocation and my commitment to God and to the Church. From my very early years in the small town I grew up in Southern Italy, I clearly remember priests who were there to welcome me when I made my way to the church in the middle of the town square. They were there with their smile and kindness, offering me holy cards and small statues of Baby Jesus and the Saints, that I would take home and treasure (I still have some of these little objects of my devotion). I remember the priest who gave me my First Holy Communion and who was there when the bishop from the nearby city confirmed me (in Grade 3). I remember with tears saying good-bye to them when my family moved to Canada (I was almost 11 yrs old).

I remember the priests I met here in Canada and who spent many hours with me in my high school quests to respond to a desire that I started nurturing in my heart, as I experienced God's call to the priesthood. Those who were there to share the joy of my ordination and continued to give me advice, guidance, support, and yes, at times (perhaps many times) helped me improve my response to emerging situations in parish life. Priests who, up to now and even today, continue with their prayer and love to sustain me, direct me and teach me. Many of them no longer in active ministry. However, the gift of who they are, what they have done, and what their prayer life and commitment continue to do is still a lamp that shines before me and guides me.
