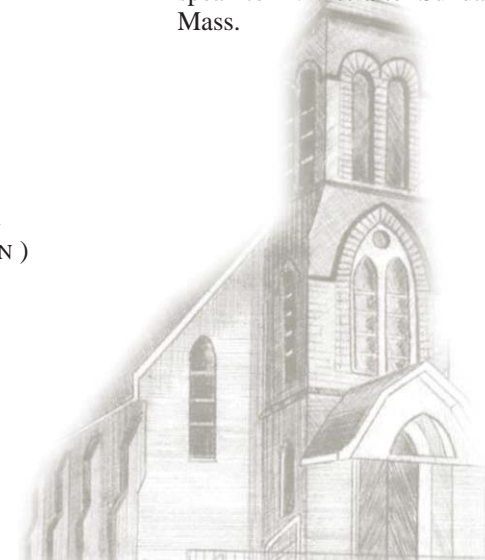

### DEVOTION TO "OUR LADY OF KNOCK"

In Ireland, a small village called KNOCK, our Blessed Mother appeared on August 21, 1879. The apparition was witnessed by at least 15 people, ranging from 5 to 75 years of age. It lasted for approximately two hours. Mary appeared with St. Joseph and St. John the Evangelist. At her left, stood an altar with a Lamb beneath a large cross, worshipped by Angels. During the apparition, Our Blessed Mother never spoke. She was simply there to comfort the people at a time when there was great suffering and pain. Mary stood with the people, her children, as she stood beneath the Cross of Christ, her Son. As we journey through the difficulties of the present days, Mary stands beneath our crosses, comforting us with her love and motherly care. We too need her presence. Beginning last Saturday, October 3rd, our parish has begun to pray to Our Lady of Knock at the beginning of every Saturday 8:30 a.m. Mass. Cards have been printed and handed out with devotional prayers. These too may be picked up and taken home, and safely shared with loved ones, as we turn to Mary with filial devotion and love.

Queen of Ireland,  
you gave hope to our people in a time of distress  
and comforted them in sorrow.  
You have inspired countless pilgrims
