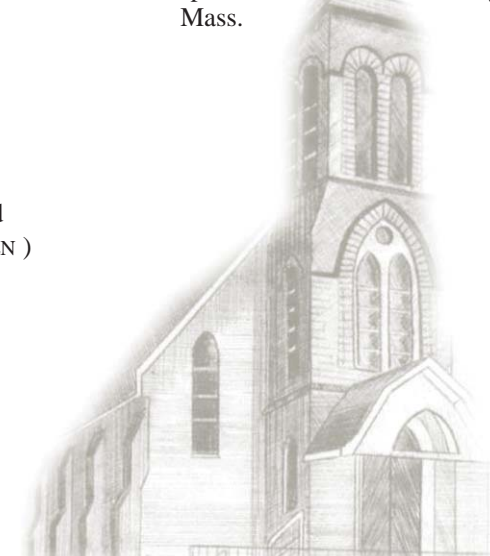

REMEMBRANCE OF THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED.



On Monday, our parish will be celebrating the Eucharist at 8:30 a.m. in English, 10 a.m. in Italian, and 7:30 p.m. in English. The Church will open half hour before each celebration, but will remain open between the two morning Masses. Because of COVID and our need to disinfect at all times, we will not be able to leave the church open all day.

In front of the Altar you will find a basket in which you may place ALL SOULS' ENVELOPES found in your envelope box. Please note that we cannot (for safety reasons) leave blank envelopes at the door, as in previous years, upon which to write names of loved ones. You may, however, if you do not have an envelope box, use any envelope or a simple sheet of paper to write names of loved ones and place in the basket. These papers with the names will remain at the altar for the entire month of November, as in each Mass your loved ones will be remembered and presented to the love and mercy of God.
