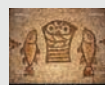

### OCTOBER, MONTH OF THE ROSARY

Conference Calls will also be part of the preparation at specific intervals. The Schedule for the celebration of the Sacraments for this group, will be made available in the new year.

**FOR THOSE CURRENTLY IN GRADE 2 OR GRADE 7 THIS SCHOOL YEAR,** please be patient and wait for further information regarding registration. We will be dealing with each of the groups in sequence as we try to clear the delay caused by the ongoing pandemic. Thank you.

As of this past Wednesday, October 6, we have concluded all First Communions and Confirmation Celebrations from the year 2020. Thank you for your patience and congratulations to every family. Please note: not all the children and some members of the families had the opportunity of celebrating the Sacrament of Confession before the dates assigned. Please note that the opportunity of going to Confession is offered every Saturday, from 3 to 4 in the afternoon. Fr. Vito will be waiting for you in the Sacristy (the Confessional cannot be used during the Pandemic). Come and celebrate the mercy and love of God.
