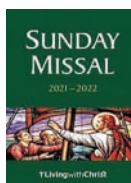

This, along with the various other measures still in place, and above all, our commitment to prayer, will strengthen our journey through this remaining time of the pandemic. A NEW FENCE ALONG THE SIDEWALK ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE CHURCH BUILDING

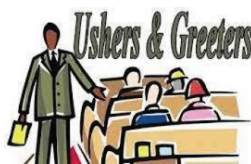
