Please notice this important message. For the year 2020, over 180 envelope boxes were never picked up. These have now been discarded. As we have no way of knowing all the

families that will pick up boxes this year, AND BECAUSE THERE IS NO SAFE WAY OF DISTRIBUTING OR PICKING UP BOXES OF ENVELOPES, THIS IS THE WAY IN WHICH NEW BOXES OF ENVELOPES WILL BE HANDED OUT.

First of all, no one will have the same box number. As you leave church over the next few weeks, please go through the sacristy, and pick up the new box of envelopes that Fr. Vito will hand out to you. From JANUARY 1st, PLEASE START USING THE NEW ENVELOPES. Write your name and address on the first few, before we record the number. PLEASE DO NOT ASK OR LOOK FOR YOUR OLD NUMBER.

As of Jan 1st, please **PUT ASIDE ALL YOUR OLD ENVELOPES.** We apologize for this, but there is no other SAFE WAY of distributing the new boxes. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.


