### FROM THE DESK OF FR. VITO

Greetings parishioners and dear friends of St. Patrick's Church - Wildfield

### A BLESSED ADVENT TO EVERYONE!

Here we are: another Advent... a new Liturgical Year beginning this weekend. The Gospel of Luke will lead us through most of the Sundays, beginning today, until the Feast of

Christ the King, next year.

In my personal time of prayer and reflection I have had and continue to have the opportunity of asking myself: "What does this year's Advent mean to me?" I would also like you to consider the same question. How can this Advent be different from the others? Remember that for us Christians Advent is not simply a time of decorating, extend greetings, etc. Advent is truly a time of new beginnings, in the light of the candles we see glowing around the Advent Wreath. How can I better prepare myself, my life, my home, my community, for Christ who comes to us, every day, in every person, in every situation. And who will one day return in glory.

Like many of you, I too have had my share of challenges during this pandemic. May I confess that I have struggled with uncertainties, with doubts, with the pain of not being able to do as much as I am accustomed of doing. Examining the little I could do and did, I questioned why I could not do more. Did I let down people who perhaps expected a bit more than what I did?

In my reflection on Advent, I am now praying that I may "get up again", "wake up", place more confidence in the fact that "it is not what I do, it is what God does in me and/or through me".

I believe that this Advent will enable me <u>to journey</u> towards Bethlehem; <u>not remain</u> in the field where the message of his birth has been announced. So, where is my Bethlehem? In the lives of the faithful. In the hospitals with the sick. In the nursing home with the seniors. In the schools, with the children and the staff.

I do not wish to remain like the "sleeping shepherd" in our manger scenes, who is totally unaware of what goes on around him. I ask the Lord to open my eyes and acknowledge his presence. Let us journey together to Bethlehem; mine and yours, where the Emmanuel is calling us to be fully alive; to worship him and to make him known.

Celebrate the Good News and, like the Angels, announce the Good News to everyone.

### AN ACTIVITY FOR THE YOUNG...


