For now, we continue to ask everyone to be patient, and to please be involved in the journey of faith through family prayer, reflections on the readings of Sunday Mass, participate in the Mass, in person or through Social Media. In the Sunday Missal, there are a number of readings and prayers for Sunday Mass. We encourage families in Sacramental preparation to purchase a Sunday Mass Missal for 2022 (\$5.00 each) so that you and your child may follow the readings from home.
