CONFESSIONS DURING THE WEEK LEADING TO CHRISTMAS



On **Monday**, Dec. 20, **Tuesday**, Dec. 21, **Wednesday**, Dec. 22, and **Thursday**, Dec. 23, Mass will be celebrated every morning at 8:30 am. On these days, CONFESSIONS will be heard from **9:15 am to 10 am** AND from

6:30 pm to 7:30 pm. Because of the tight schedule of masses on Dec. 24 and 25, it will not be possible to hear confessions. This Christmas let us celebrate the **MERCY OF GOD** in the Sacrament of **RECONCILIATION**. Please note that with COVID regulations, confessions are heard in the SACRISTY for safety reasons.

CHALKING (Marking) THE DOOR OF THE HOUSE FOR THE EPIPHANY BLESSING



There is a tradition in many countries that on the Feast of the Epiphany of Our Lord, which in Canada is the SUNDAY AFTER NEW YEAR'S DAY (this year on January 2), the doors of the homes are chalked as the homes are blessed. On the FRAME OF THE DOOR, as a sign of the blessing, chalk is

used to mark the year of the Blessing. Those who wish to embrace this tradition will pick up a blessed piece of chalk from church after Mass on The Epiphany Sunday, along with a prayer for blessing, and upon returning home, the family could gather at the door, recite the prayer and write the following on the frame of the door (or choose a door in the house where this could be done). 20 + C + M + B + 22 The year that we are beginning is marked by placing the first two numbers at the beginning and two numbers at the end. Crosses then divide each section as the letters C M B are included between the two sets of numbers. These letters represent the NAMES OF THE MAGI (Casper, Melchior, Balthasar) and the Latin phrase Christus, Mansionem Benedicat which means May Christ Bless this House.

Merlyka, one of our parishioners has volunteered to create a special plaque which you can hang at the entrance of your house with the above beautifully and artistically presented. There is a copy available in the Sacristy for you to see. The charge of \$10 applies exclusively to the materials used. However, you need to order it immediately so that it can be made available for you to pick up from the sacristy on Epiphany morning (Jan. 2). To order please call Merlyka directly at 416-880-1643.

FIRST COMMUNION / CONFIRMATION

REGISTERED IN SPRING 2021

We anticipate celebrations to happen in Spring of 2022. Sometime in Early 2022 we will announce dates for the celebrations of First Confession, First Communions, and Confirmation. We will also let families know how they will be able to choose their celebration from the list of dates that we will announce. Celebrations are not done in school groups.

FOR THOSE CURRENTLY IN GRADES 2 AND 7

We are aiming for registrations sometimes in Early 2022, and we anticipate celebrations to happen sometime in the Fall of 2022. For now, we continue to ask everyone to be patient, and to please be involved in the journey of faith through family prayer, reflections on the readings of Sunday Mass, participate in the Mass, in person or through Social Media. In the Sunday Missal, there are a number of readings and prayers for Sunday Mass. We encourage families in Sacramental preparation to purchase a Sunday Mass Missal for 2022 (\$5.00 each) so that you and your child may follow the readings from home.
