NEW ENVELOPES FOR THE YEAR 2022

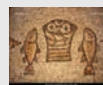

In the first reading this Sunday we learn all about the importance of trust. The Lord says to the prophet Jeremiah, **"Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord ... That**

person shall be like a tree planted by water, sending out its roots by the stream. It shall not fear when heat comes, and its leaves shall stay green."

Let us take some time to reflect on the role of trust in our lives as stewards. Being a steward involves the total gift of our time and talents to our parish community for the good of the Church. However, despite all our good deeds, we may not always see the fruit of our labours. The parish vitality may still seem bleak or people may still seem to lack interior conversion.
