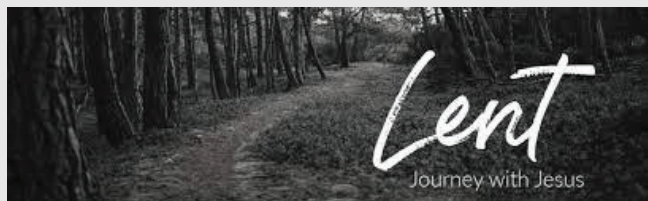

FROM THE DESK OF
FR. AUGUSTO

Dear parishioners,

Now allow me to conclude by quoting from Fr. Vito's last bulletin message: **"I want to reassure you that you are not alone. My prayers are constantly with you, and you are remembered at every mass. Be strong. If, at times, you feel strength is vanishing, please rely on the strength of Jesus."**
