Holy Week is a time of final preparations and great anticipation. Our long term preparations of prayers, fasting and almsgiving during Lent will continue but with greater intensity. Palm Sunday is our doorway into the holiest week of the Church year with Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem; his gift of the Eucharist; and his suffering, death and Resurrection. The three solemn liturgies on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday (Easter Vigil) are called the **Triduum**.
