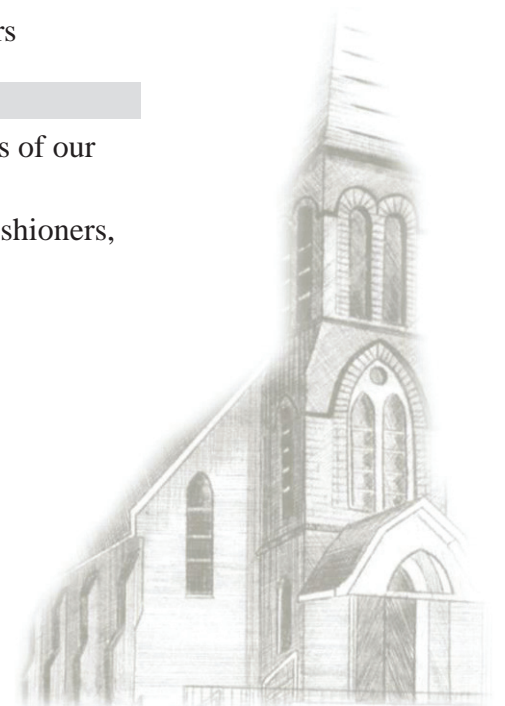

Preparation for and the celebration of Confession allows us to set aside disruptive ways, to be renewed in heart and spirit, to be reconciled with our God who abounds with gracious, gentle tenderness.

In our parish, **Confessions are regularly available on Saturdays from 4:00pm to 4:45pm.** You can also set-up an appointment for Confession through the Office.

It has been the practice across the Archdiocese of Toronto to hold Days of Confessions for Advent and Lent, to expand the availability of this great Sacrament. In our parish, **the Advent Day of Confessions will be on Thursday 15 December.** Confessions will be available from **10:00am to 12noon, 2:00pm to 4:00pm, and 6:00pm to 9:00pm.**
