

FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 2



This feast reminds us of the day when Mary and Joseph presented the Christ Child to the Temple. His coming fulfills the ancient expectations, as presented in the presence of Simeon and Anna, the prophet. On this day we bless and distribute candles. We will give a box to each family, with two white candles, symbol of two doves that Mary and Joseph presented; the offering of the poor. If you are not able to attend, but wish to receive the candles, please let us know, we will put them aside and give them to you on the weekend.

This day, February 2nd, is also the **World day of Prayer for Consecrated Life**. We remember the religious (nuns, monks) who have given their life to the church dedicated to prayer and work, many times unseen, and perhaps not even appreciated by many. May the Lord welcome their consecration and their work. They are, as some have described, the "breathing lungs" of the life of the Church.
