## RUNNING FOR CATHOLIC SCHOOL TRUSTEE

Dufferin-Peel's Catholic schools are overseen by a board of 11 elected trustees. Trustees serve as system leaders of publicly funded education in their communities and province. They work collaboratively with their community to shape a vision for the board that is reflective of the input of parents, students and community members. Trustees advocate for excellence in education and act as role models to engender confidence in publicly funded education. In addition, Catholic school trustees have a clearly defined role as stewards and guardians of Catholic education. Municipal elections, including the election of Catholic School Trustees, take place every four years. The Municipal and School Board elections will be held this year on October 24, 2022. The Nomination and Campaign Period for the elections will begin on May 2, 2022. The last day for nominations is August 19, 2022.

To be eligible for election to a four-year term as a Catholic school trustee, you must be:

- \***Roman Catholic**
- \***Catholic school supporter**
- \***Resident within the jurisdiction of the district Catholic school board**
- \***Canadian citizen at least 18 years of age**

## DIRECTION OF SCHOOL SUPPORT

Catholic ratepayers must declare themselves to be Catholic and an English Separate (Catholic) School Supporter on their municipal property tax designation to cast a vote for Catholic school trustees in the municipal election. To check if you are registered as an English Catholic School supporter, check the assessment section of your Tax Bill or Property Assessment Notice, check your Voter Information Card or visit [voterlookup.ca](http://voterlookup.ca) to check the accuracy of your direction of school support or you may contact the DPCDSB Admissions Department at 905-890-0708 ext. 24512 or [admissions@dpcdsb.org](mailto:admissions@dpcdsb.org).
