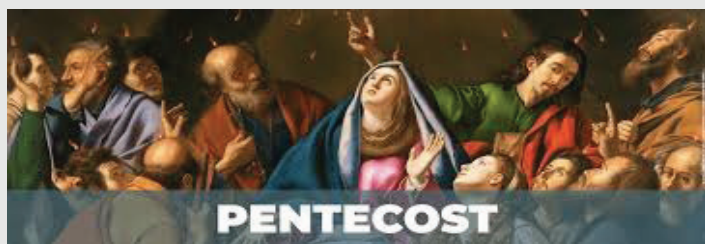

**"Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful; and kindle in them the fire of your love."**

Today is Pentecost Sunday, the 50th day after Easter. Pentecost is often called the **"birthday of the Church."** It commemorates the day the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples and they first began proclaiming the Gospel. This was the mark of the successful completion of Jesus' earthly mission. We should never fail to marvel at the fact that 2000 years later the Church is still active and growing. Let us strive to invoke the Holy Spirit in all of our stewardship efforts and continue to celebrate the greatness of the Catholic Church.
