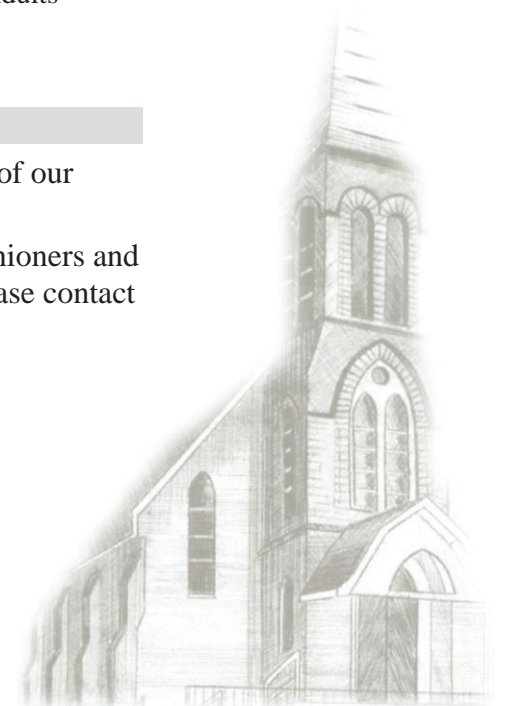

Dear parishioners,
