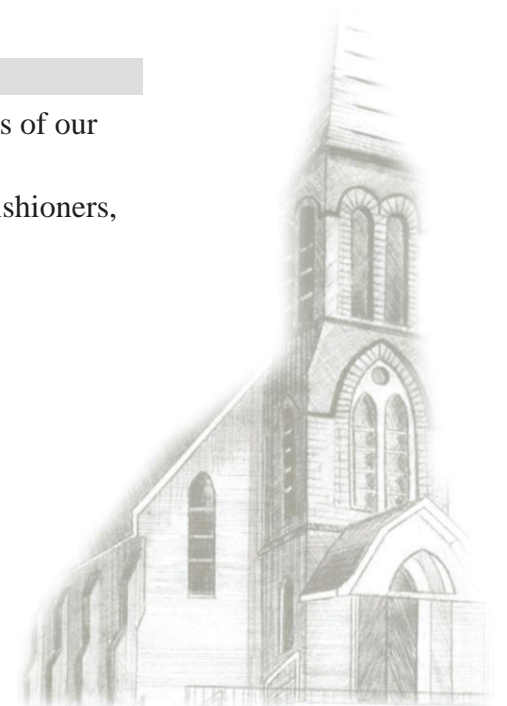

CONFIRMATION CELEBRATIONS

We congratulate and pray for the young people of our parish who are celebrating their Confirmation during this period.

GETTING READY FOR THE NEXT CYCLE OF SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

It is common practice in the Archdiocese of Toronto that children in Grade 2 become eligible for First Communion and those in Grade 7 become eligible for Confirmation.

Families with children entering Grade 2 or 7 in September 2023 (or older children who have yet to receive these sacraments), are asked to prepare a copy of the children's Baptism certificate, available from the church where they were baptized. This will be a requirement for registrations in Fall 2023. *Families with children baptized here at St Patrick's, Wildfield do not need to provide a copy of the certificate.*

Registrations for these Sacraments will not be until after the new school year starts in Fall 2023, but we are asking you to begin preparations for this now.
