

GETTING READY FOR THE NEXT CYCLE OF SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

It is common practice in the Archdiocese of Toronto that children in Grade 2 become eligible for First Communion and those in Grade 7 become eligible for Confirmation.

Families with children entering Grade 2 or 7 in September 2023 (or older children who have vet to receive these Sacraments), are asked to prepare a copy of the children's Baptism certificate, available from the church where they were baptized. This will be a requirement for registrations in Fall 2023. Families with children baptized here at St Patrick's do not need to provide a copy of the certificate.

The initial Information Meeting for parents are scheduled at 7:00 p.m. on the following days here at the church:

- First Communion Tuesday 26 September 2023
- Confirmation Wednesday 27 September 2023

The meetings will begin with Mass at 7:00 p.m. with the formal meeting to follow after Mass. Registration forms will be handed out at these meetings.

First Communion preparations consist of Sunday Mass, parents' meetings, and at-home activities. Confirmation preparations consist of Sunday Mass and Candidates' meetings. For the full schedule of the preparation program (including tentative celebration dates), please visit our parish website.

A NOTE ABOUT TEACHER APPLICATIONS AND PASTORAL REFERENCES

Dear prospective teachers / Parents of prospective teachers,

Thank you for your interest in teaching and leading the next generation of students through Catholic education. Your decision to form the minds, hearts and souls of our youth is valued and of utmost importance.

Because our Catholic schools exist not just to impart knowledge but to instill students with wisdom and love, we must do everything we can to ensure the teachers that are hired are as qualified as possible, above all in the matters of the Faith. St Pope Paul VI notes, "Modern man listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers, and if he does listen to teachers, it is because they are witnesses" (Evangelii Nuntiandi, #41).

To this end, anyone wishing to receive a Pastoral Reference Letter as part of their application for employment in a Catholic school board must be known to the pastor here by their regular attendance at Sunday Mass (*i.e.* weekly). To those who are going away for teacher's college, a letter may be obtained from the pastor of the church where you go to school. If you are the parent of a student away at teachers' college, kindly ensure that your child knows that reference letters can only be given to those who are actively involved in the life of this parish.

Please pray for all involved in the wonderful work of Catholic education.
