Ivan Jurkovič will confer the pallium, a symbol of the archbishop's role as shepherd to the faithful. Following Mass, there will be an informal reception with light refreshments in the Cathedral atrium and courtyard. Seating will be first come, first served. All are welcome to join in this special celebration for our archdiocese and archbishop!
