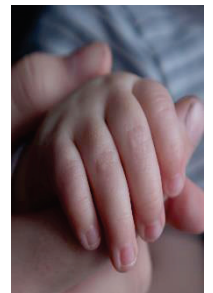
Online Lecture | 7 November 2023 at 8:00 p.m.
