During the last days of Advent, from the 17 to 23 December (just before Christmas Eve), the Church intensifies Her prayer of longing for the coming of the Lord. This is most clearly expressed through the "O Antiphons" that are used during Evening Prayers on these days. They also appear as the verse for the Gospel Acclamation at the daily Mass. Each verse begins with a title from the Old Testament that we now attribute to the person of Jesus Christ. The hymn O Come, O Come, *Emmanuel* is a well-known setting of these antiphons. Let us join the whole Church in crying out for the Lord to come into our lives especially in these great days of Advent.
