#### A REMINDER ABOUT MASS INTENTIONS

This is a summary of an announcement that was published in the bulletin of 10 July 2022.

As a general guideline, in accord with Canon 948 of the Code of Canon Law and the particular norms of the Archdiocese of Toronto, we can only have one intention per Mass. Usually this means one name or one family only listed as the intention for each Mass. The guidelines allow for us to set aside one Mass – in our case Friday mornings at 8:30 a.m. – where we can accommodate multiple Mass intentions.
