

DID YOU KNOW?

29 January is the anniversary of the ordination of Father Francis McSpiritt to the priesthood. He was ordained at Saint Michael's Cathedral in Toronto in the year 1865. Following his ordination, he was sent to be associated pastor

here at our parish until March 1867. He later returned as pastor in November 1887 until his death on 14 August 1895. Known for his ministry especially to those who were sick and in need of healing, FR MAC oversaw the construction of our current church building.
