

Families with children *entering* Grade 2 (anticipating the celebration of First Communion) and students *entering* Grade 7 (anticipating the celebration of Confirmation), as well as older children for either Sacrament should begin to consider next year's preparation and celebration cycle.

Parents are asked to prepare a copy of the Baptism certificate of their child (available from the church where they were Baptized). This will be a requirement for the registration that will happen sometime in Fall 2024. Families are also reminded that the Sacraments should be celebrated at the parish church that they regularly attend on Sundays, regardless of which parish their child's school is connected.
