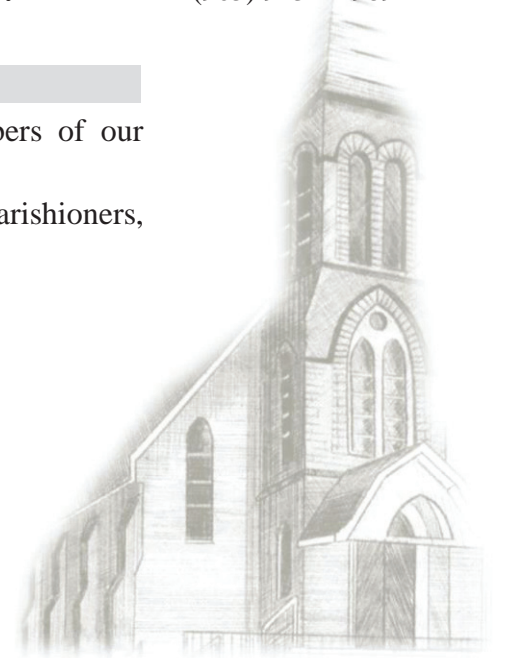

GETTING READY FOR THE NEXT CYCLE OF SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

It is common practice in the Archdiocese of Toronto that children in Grade 2 become eligible for First Communion and those in Grade 7 become eligible for Confirmation.

Families with children entering Grade 2 or 7 in September 2024 (or older children who have yet to receive these Sacraments), are asked to prepare a copy of the children's Baptism certificate, available from the church where they were baptized. This will be a requirement for registrations in Fall 2024. Families

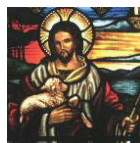
**PILGRIMAGE TO THE MARTYRS' SHRINE IN MIDLAND
