

You have three options to participate in this consultation survey:

You may drop-off the completed questionnaire in the regular Sunday collection basket, or in the box in the sacristy after Mass during the week. **OPTION TWO**: You may **download a copy** of the questionnaire by going to **http://StPatricksBR.archtoronto.org/survey** (or by scanning the QR code) and fill it out electronically. You may then *either* e-mail your responses to the parish office, or print out the completed questonnaire and drop it off as in the first option.

OPTION THREE: A **completely online version of the questionnaire** is also found on our website for those who choose to submit their responses online.

The consultation/survey period will run until Thanksgiving Monday 14 October 2024. Responses to the questionnaire will be accepted until then. We thank you in advanced for your participation in this endeavour.
