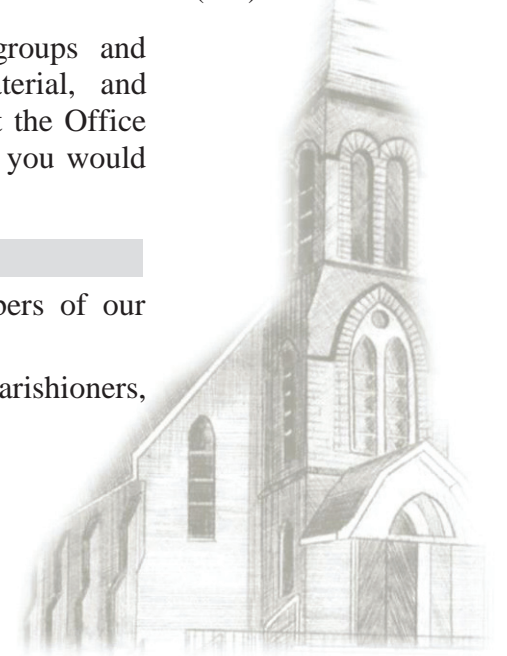

Copies of the new **Sunday Missal (2024-2025)** will be made available for sale in a few weeks' time.

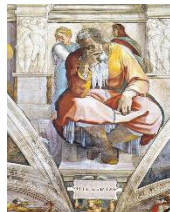
