

MARRIAGE SUNDAY Sunday 9 February 2025

Marriage Sunday is celebrated to highlight the importance of the Sacrament of Marriage and to affirm couples who strengthen our faith community through their witness. It also honours those who nurture marriage ministries such preparation and enrichment.
