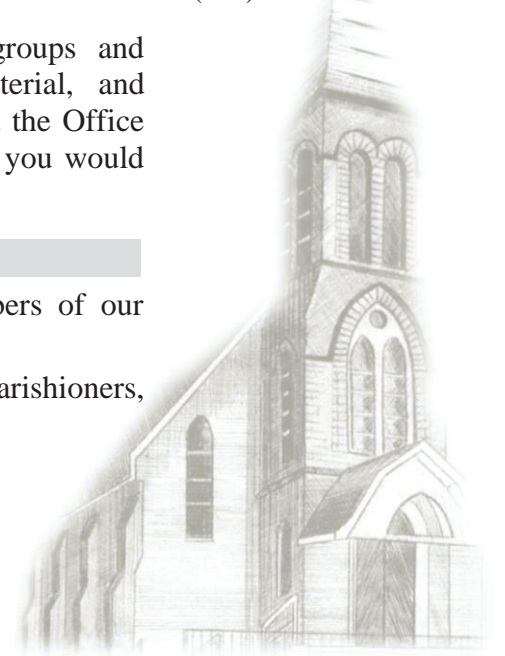

The Rosary is also prayed in the church before the first Mass of each day: Sunday to Friday at 8:00 a.m., and Saturday at 8:30 a.m.

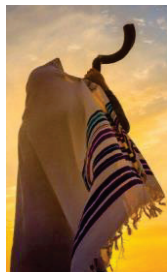
REGIONAL CELEBRATIONS WITH HIS EMINENCE FRANK CARDINAL LEO

JUBILEE YEAR 2025



The word **jubilee** comes from the Hebrew word **yobel** which refers to the horn of a ram. This horn was blown to signal the celebration of a year of favour when slaves are set free, debts are erased, land is returned to their rightful owner, and all is set right before God. This year of favour occurred for the ancient Jews once every 50 years and we see it described in Chapter 25 of the book of Leviticus. The Church points to this as the origins of the practice of proclaiming jubilee years, such as the one we are currently celebrating.

The Holy Doors of Saint Peter's Basilica at the Vatican are open until 6 January 2026. Jubilee celebrations are observed around the world until 28 December 2025.

In the Archdiocese of Toronto, several churches have been designated as pilgrimage sites for the duration of the Jubilee, including:

- Saint Michael's Cathedral Basilica, Toronto
- Saint Paul's Basilica, Toronto
- Martyrs' Shrine, Midland
- Saint Padre Pio, Kleinburg
- Saint Mary's, Brampton
