### ACROSS THE ARCHDIOCESE





During Jubilee Years, the Church invites the faithful to rediscover the gift of **indulgences**. These are concrete manifestations of God's mercy that surpasses and transforms the limits of human justice. The *Catechism* defines indulgences as the "remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven" (paragraph 1471). They allow the faithful believer to free their heart from the burden of sin and to experience the profound mercy of God.

Indulgences are granted, either on a plenary (full) or partial basis, to the Christian faithful who take up certain meritorious works accompanied by usual conditions: complete detachment from sin, reception of the Eucharist at Mass on the day of the meritorious work, celebration of Confession within a couple of weeks (roughly 20 days) of the meritorious work, and prayers for the intentions of the Pope. During Jubilee Years, a plenary indulgence (under the usual conditions) is granted to all who make a pilgrimage through the Holy Doors of each of the Papal Basilicas in Rome. During this Jubilee Year, pilgrimage churches are designated in each diocese for those who are not able to make the trip to Rome.

The Holy Doors of Saint Peter's Basilica at the Vatican are open until 6 January 2026. Jubilee celebrations are observed around the world until 28 December 2025.

In the Archdiocese of Toronto, several churches have been designated as pilgrimage sites for the duration of the Jubilee, including:

- ·Saint Michael's Cathedral Basilica, Toronto
- •Saint Paul's Basilica, Toronto •Saint Padre Pio, Kleinburg
- •Martyrs' Shrine, Midland •Saint Mary's, Brampton


