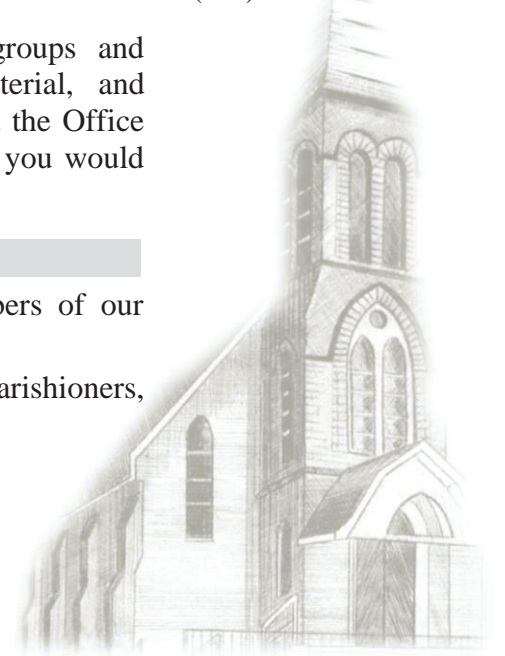

Note about the conference call: In the vast majority of cases these will be considered "local outgoing," and should be free of charge. However, some phone plans – especially those with a monthly limit of calling minutes – may be subject to additional fees from your service provider. Please check with your phone service provider for details if toll-free numbers are accessible to you with no additional fees.

The Rosary is also prayed in the church before the first Mass of each day: Sunday to Friday at 8:00 a.m., and Saturday at 8:30 a.m.



On the eve of the anniversary of the passing of Father Vito, there will be a vigil rosary following the 7:00 p.m. Mass on Tuesday 11 February 2025. Those who cannot attend in person may wish to participate by an audio feed provided by conference call.

On the day of the anniversary, in addition to the regular parish Masses at 8:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., there will be a special Mass at 10:00 a.m. at the chapel of Cardinal Ambrozic H.S. where a stained glass window will be presented in memory of Father Vito. REGIONAL CELEBRATIONS WITH HIS EMINENCE FRANK CARDINAL LEO

Masses will be celebrated by Cardinal Leo across the archdiocese to allow for the faithful to join in prayerful thanksgiving for his elevation to the College of Cardinals.

The Cardinal will preside over Mass at Saint Padre Pio, Kleinburg on Tuesday 4 February 2025 at 7:00 p.m.



For the Jubilee Year of 2025, the Apostolic Penitentiary (the Vatican office that issues decrees about indulgences) has announced that a plenary indulgence is granted to the Christian Faithful who make a pilgrimage to Rome and pass through the Holy Doors at the four Papal Basilicas. Recognizing that the majority of people are not able to make the trip to Rome, the plenary indulgence of the Jubilee Year can be obtained (under the usual conditions) through the several actions including:

- making a pilgrimage or pious visit to a local church specifically designated as a Jubilee pilgrimage church;
- participating in faith formation activities in parishes and dioceses based on the Vatican II documents or the Catechism of the Catholic Church;
- performing corporal and spiritual works of mercy, especially the visiting of the sick, imprisoned, and homebound;
- taking up penances such as fasting from food or abstaining from meat, including fasting for at least one day from "futile distractions" such as social media, television, video games, and certain phone apps.

In the Archdiocese of Toronto, several churches have been designated as pilgrimage sites for the duration of the Jubilee, including:

- Saint Michael's Cathedral Basilica, Toronto
- Saint Paul's Basilica, Toronto
- Martyrs' Shrine, Midland
- Saint Padre Pio, Kleinburg
- Saint Mary's, Brampton

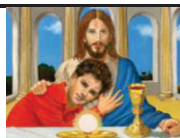
