ACROSS THE ARCHDIOCESE





An indulgence is the "remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraph 1471). It is a not a full or pre-emptive pardon for sins and wrongdoings, rather it is the assurance that the merits of Christ, the Saints, and the Church are there as help for us on life's journey towards the eternal joys of heaven. This is why the usual conditions for obtaining an indulgence includes a disposition of complete detachment from sin and the celebration of Reconciliation (Confession) in addition to receiving Communion at Mass and praying for the Pope and his intentions. Any Catholic, having performed a meritorious work under these conditions, receives an indulgence which can be either plenary (full) or partial. The faithful may obtain several partial and one plenary indulgence each day. During a Jubilee Year, a second plenary indulgence may be obtained by the faithful!

In the Archdiocese of Toronto, several churches have been designated as pilgrimage sites for the duration of the Jubilee, including:


