A REMINDER ABOUT MASS INTENTIONS

In accord with Canon 948 of the Code of Canon Law and the particular norms of the Archdiocese of Toronto:

- One regularly-scheduled Sunday Mass has to be celebrated "PRO POPULO," which means "for the people of the parish." In our parish this means that one of our English Masses every weekend will be reserved for this intention.
- Only one intention per Mass is allowed. Usually this means that only
 one name or one family is listed as the intention for each Mass.
- One weekday Mass can be designated to have multiple intentions. In our parish this is the Friday 8:30 a.m. Mass, at which we will be able to have multiple names and intentions.

For the 11:30 a.m. Italian Mass on Sunday, we are asking everyone to limit the number of Masses requested for specific individuals and families throughout the year so that others may also have the opportunity for their intention to be presented at the Italian Mass.

Intentions already listed in our Mass book will be honoured, but we will adhere to these guidelines as much as we can moving forward.

JUBILEE YEAR 2025

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (paragraphs 1471 and following) defines an Indulgence as "a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints." In order to better understand this concept, we can think of sin as having a double consequence: an "eternal punishment" (by which we our relationships with God and the Church are damaged or destroyed, and our capacity for eternal life is compromised) and a "temporal punishment" (by which we develop an unhealthy attachment to created things that makes us more susceptible to temptation and further sin). While the eternal punishment is removed by the absolution of sins in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, the temporal punishment must be purified. For the most part, this purification or purgation happens in the state after death called Purgatory. The blessed souls who die in a state of grace but are in need of purification from the temporal punishment due to sin go through this state before entering the blessedness of Heaven. In the same way, but while still on earth, the temporal punishment is removed for those who receive an Indulgence either on a partial or plenary (full) basis.

In the Archdiocese of Toronto, several churches have been designated as pilgrimage sites for the duration of the Jubilee, including:


