



The current cycle of Confirmations and first Communions have been completed. The next cycle will begin in Fall 2025. Families who anticipate joining the next cycle of preparations are asked to prepare a copy of the Baptism certificate of their children. This will be a requirement when registrations begin the Fall.

Children who are in Grade 2 as of September 2025, and older children who have yet to receive first Communion, are eligible for the next cycle.

Students who are in Grade 7 as of September 2025, and older students who have yet to celebrate Confirmation, are eligible for the next cycle.
