#### WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY

The fifth World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be celebrated this year on **Sunday 27 July 2025**. Pope Francis instituted this World Day in 2021 to be celebrated by the universal Church every July, on or near the liturgical Memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, grandparents of Jesus. This year's theme is "Blessed are those who have not lost hope" (Cf. Sirach 14:2). Pope Leo XIV, in a written message on the occasion, reminds us that the Bible abounds with examples of men and women "whom the Lord called late in life to play a part in his saving plan." The World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly is an excellent opportunity for families and faith communities to seek ways to cherish and care for our elders, uplifting them as signs of hope for future generations.



The Annual Mass for the Faithful Departed around the feast of Our Lady's Assumption will be celebrated on **Wednesday 13 August 2025 at 7:00 p.m.** at all the Catholic cemeteries across the Archdiocese of Toronto.
