

# RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

The **RCIA** Program is for adults who wish to become full members of the Catholic Church. These could either be:

- adults who have never been Baptized;
- individuals baptized in another Christian denomination who now wish to be Catholic;
- adult Catholics who have yet to be Confirmed or receive the Eucharist for the first time

The RCIA Program runs from Fall 2025 to Spring 2026, with the celebration of the Sacraments happening on Holy Saturday Night (4 April 2026).

Individuals who are interested in joining the RCIA Program are asked to contact the parish office, or speak to one of our priests after Mass on Sunday.



## Pre-Authorized Giving Plan (PAG)

The P.A.G. Plan allows for you to set automatic monthly withdrawals directly from your chequing account to donate to our parish. 
