

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

The **RCIA** Program is for adults who wish to become full members of the Catholic Church. These could either be:

- adults who have never been Baptized;
- individuals baptized in another Christian denomination who now wish to be Catholic;
- adult Catholics who have yet to be Confirmed or receive the Eucharist for the first time

The RCIA Sessions are tentatively scheduled to begin on Thursday 16 October 2025 with Mass at 7:00 p.m. The program will until Spring 2026, with the celebration of the Sacraments happening on Holy Saturday Night (4 April 2026). Individuals who are interested in joining the RCIA Program are asked to contact the parish office, or speak to one of our priests after Mass on Sunday.

Registrations are now **open** for the Sacraments. Completed registration forms along with other requirements for registration can be handed in:

- Tuesday to Thursday, between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., until Thursday 9 October
- After every Sunday Mass (including Saturday evenings), until Sunday 12 October

Registration forms must be accompanied by the registration fee, and a copy of the child's Baptism certificate, and completion of the Parents' Questionnaire.

Registration forms for first Communion and Confirmation were handed out at the Information Meetings (Tuesday 23 September and Wednesday 24 September). Those who missed the meetings can receive a registration form after Sunday Mass until Sunday 12 October.


