RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

The **RCIA** Program is for adults who wish to become full members of the Catholic Church. These could either be:

- adults who have never been Baptized;
- individuals baptized in another Christian denomination who now wish to be Catholic;
- adult Catholics who have yet to be Confirmed or receive the Eucharist for the first time

The RCIA Sessions are scheduled to begin on Thursday 16 October 2025 with Mass at 7:00 p.m. The program will until until Spring 2026, with the celebration of the Sacraments happening on Holy Saturday Night (4 April 2026).

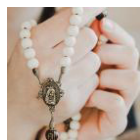
Healing after Abortion

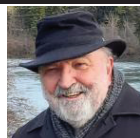

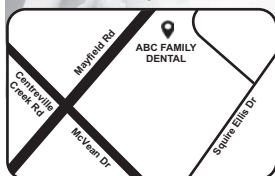
