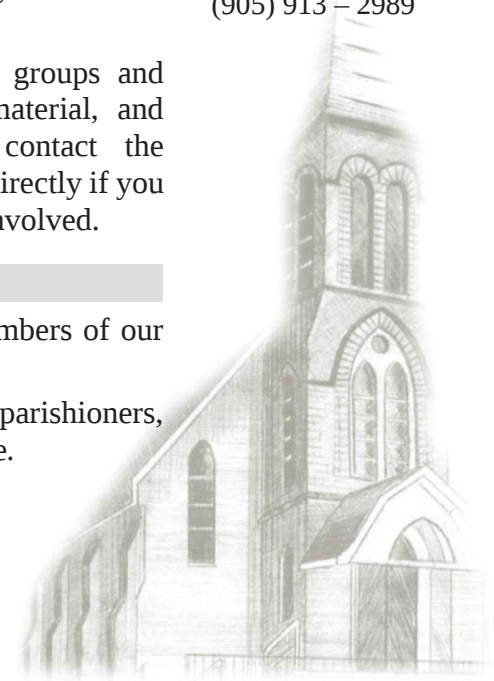

Gospel according to Saint Luke 21:28

The 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time each year is marked by the Church as the World Day of the Poor. In this year's message for the occasion, Pope Leo XVI says that "the poor can be witnesses to a strong and steadfast hope, precisely because they embody it in the midst of uncertainty, poverty, instability and marginalization." The Pope also says that "the poor are not a distraction for the Church, but our beloved brothers and sisters, for by their lives, their words and their wisdom, they put us in contact with the truth of the Gospel." You can read the entire message, as well as his recent exhortation Dilexi Te (on love for the poor), as posted on the Vatican's website.

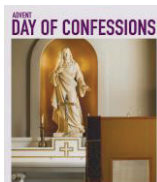
Join us for the **Rosary at 8:00 a.m.** and **Mass at 8:30 a.m.** for this great feast honouring Our Lady.

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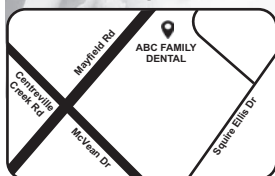


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
