A REMINDER ABOUT MASS INTENTIONS

In accord with Canon 948 of the Code of Canon Law and the particular norms of the Archdiocese of Toronto:

- **One regularly-scheduled Sunday Mass has to be celebrated “PRO POPULO,” which means “for the people of the parish.”** In our parish this means that one of our English Masses every weekend will be reserved for this intention.
- **Only one intention per Mass is allowed.** Usually this means that only one name or one family is listed as the intention for each Mass.
- **One weekday Mass can be designated to have multiple intentions.** In our parish this is the Friday 8:30 a.m. Mass, at which we will be able to have multiple names and intentions.

For the 11:30 a.m. Italian Mass on Sunday, we are asking everyone to limit the number of Masses requested for specific individuals and families throughout the year so that others may also have the opportunity for their intention to be presented at the Italian Mass.
