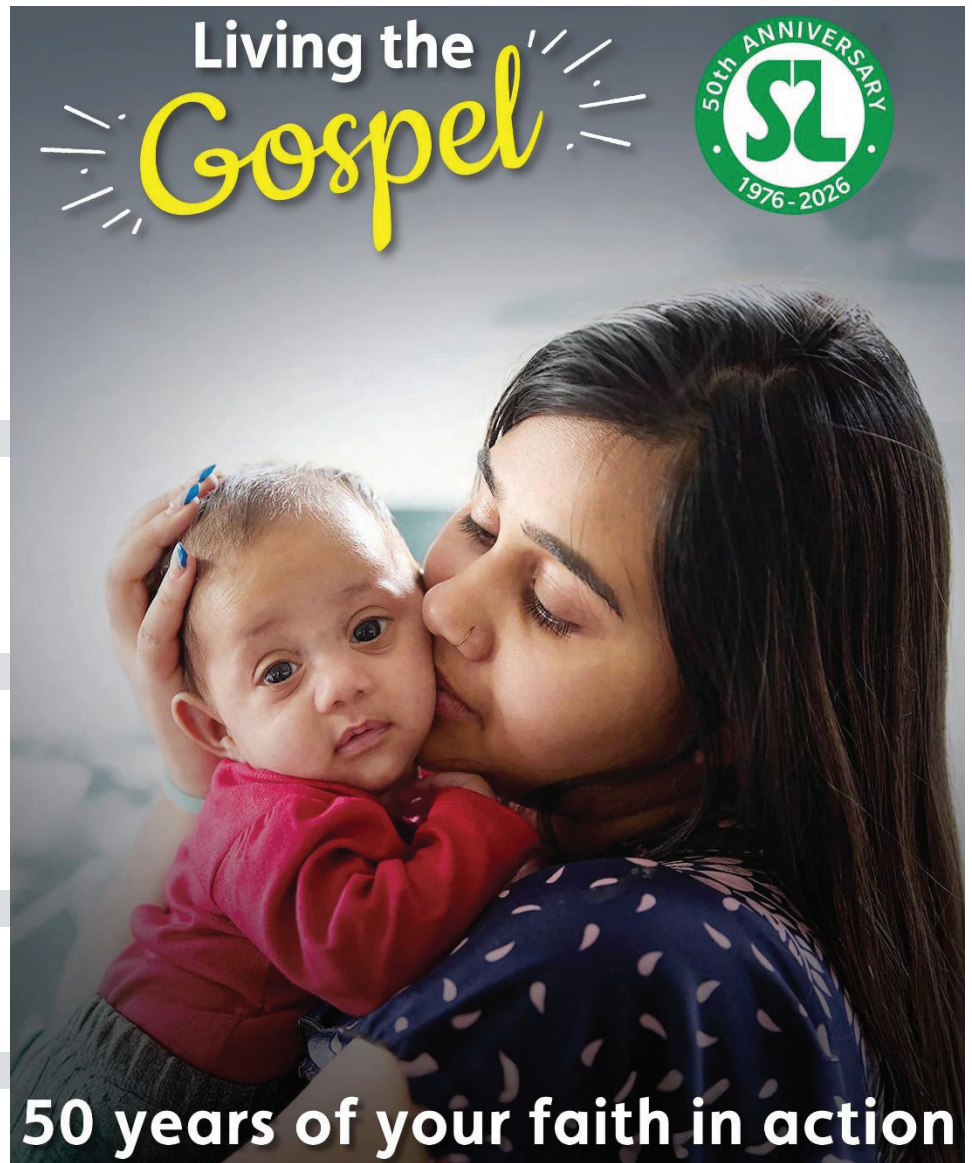

#### A REMINDER ABOUT MASS INTENTIONS

In accord with Canon 948 of the Code of Canon Law and the particular norms of the Archdiocese of Toronto:

- **One regularly-scheduled Sunday Mass has to be celebrated "PRO POPULO,"** which means "for the people of the parish." One of our English Masses every weekend will be reserved for this intention.
- **Only one intention per Mass is allowed.** Usually this means that only one name or one family is listed as the intention for each Mass.
- **One weekday Mass can be designated to have multiple intentions.** In our parish this is the Friday 8:30 a.m. Mass, at which we will be able to have multiple names and intentions.

For the 11:30 a.m. Italian Mass on Sunday, we are asking everyone to limit the number of Masses requested for specific individuals and families throughout the year so that others may also have the opportunity for their intention to be presented at the Italian Mass.

**PROTECT MENTAL HEALTH, PROTECT LIFE: SUPPORT BILL C-218**

**WRITE YOUR MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT TODAY!**

You are invited to visit [HelpNotHarmCanada.ca](http://HelpNotHarmCanada.ca) to quickly and respectfully contact your Member of Parliament and ask for their support of Bill C-218 (The Right to Recover Act). This proposed legislation would amend the Criminal Code to ensure that Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) is not extended to individuals whose sole underlying condition is mental illness.



If the law is not amended, MAiD will become available for those suffering from mental illness alone beginning in March 2027. Many of us know someone living with mental illness – a loved one, friend, neighbour, or colleague. As Catholics and Canadians, we are called to

respond with compassion, accompaniment, and genuine care, safeguarding the dignity and lives of those who are vulnerable.
