The RCIA Program is for adults who wish to become full members of the Catholic Church. These could either be:

- adults who have never been Baptized;
- individuals Baptized in another Christian denomination who now wish to be Catholic;
- adult Catholics who have yet to be Confirmed or receive the Eucharist for the first time

The RCIA Program runs from Fall 2026 to Spring 2027, with the celebration of the Sacraments happening on Holy Saturday Night (27 March 2027).

**Individuals who are interested in joining the RCIA Program are asked to contact the parish office, or speak to one of our priests after Mass on Sunday.** We also encourage all RCIA Candidates to begin the practice of regularly participating at Sunday Mass.

Students who are in Grade 7 as of September 2026, and older students who have yet to celebrate **Confirmation**, are eligible for the next cycle.
